Historical Note about Asbury United Methodist Church

Asbury Memorial UMC began as a Methodist "society" in the log home of pioneer Daniel Killian, on what is now Elk Mountain Scenic Highway. Francis Asbury, the first bishop of the Methodist Episcopal Church in the United States. presided over the church's first recorded quarterly meeting on October 11, 1801. The present brick building is the third to stand on the property, which has never been bought or sold. Killian explored and filed the original claim on the surrounding lands, and his descendants deeded the property to a Board of Trustees, that it might be used as a "church and burying ground forever."
