¹² For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the embers of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body- Jews or Greeks, ever or free- and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

¹⁴ Indeed, the body does not consist of one member but many. ¹⁵ If the ot would say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," at would not make it any less a part of the body. ¹⁶And if the ear would y, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," that would t make it any less a part of the body. ¹⁷If the whole body were an eye, here would the hearing be? If the whole body were hearing, where ould the sense of smell be? ¹⁸But as it is, God arranged the members in body, each one of them, as he chose. ¹⁹If all were a single member, here would the body be? ²⁰As it is, there are many members, yet one dy. ²¹The eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you," nor again head to the feet, "I have no need of you." ²²On the contrary, the embers of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, ²³ and those embers of the body that we think less honorable we clothe with greater nor, and our less respectable members are treated with greater respect; vhereas our more respectable members do not need this. But God has so anged the body, giving the greater honor to the inferior member, ²⁵that ere may be no dissension within the body, but the members may have same care for one another. ²⁶If one member suffers, all suffer together th it; if one member is honored, all rejoice together with it.

²⁷Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it. And God has appointed in the church first apostles, second prophets, rd teachers; then deeds of power, then gifts of healing, forms of sistance, forms of leadership, various kinds of tongues. ²⁹Are all ostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles? ³⁰Do possess gifts of healing? Do all speak in tongues? Do all interpret? But strive for the greater gifts.
