

# NEWS FROM THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN & BUILDING COMMITTEES



The Building Committee continues to move forward in our work on Phase I of the construction. We have been meeting with contractors, engineers, and architects regarding the construction work and timeline for the improvements to the exterior of the church building and property.

The Building Committee had invited five different contractors to bid on our project. Unfortunately, due to the volume of construction that is happening in and around Asheville, there is an acute shortage of available contractors and sub-contractors. Three of those five

who had been invited to submit bids had to withdraw their bids because they were unable to find sub-contractors to complete the work necessary on our project. In the end, we received two bids: the first bid was over \$200,000 above our working budget for Phase 1, and the second bid was about \$80,000 over our budget for Phase 1.

Given the expected cost of the project, the Building Committee was forced to either (1) increase our budget and ask the congregation for more money, or (2) to revise the project and eliminate or delay some of what we had hoped to do. It was decided that the work on the south side of the property (the new driveway, parking lot, covered entryway, and Memorial Garden) was the most important. Therefore, it was decided to modify our project by not doing the work that had been planned for the north side.

We had hoped to be able to start construction in June, but we are still waiting on the requisite permits from the City of Asheville and will commence construction as soon as we are able—hopefully still this summer.

#### NEWS FROM THE MISSIONS COMMITTEE

The June Bread Tin offering, a loose change offering, will benefit Nothing But Nets, an organization that seeks to protect children from malaria, one of the leading causes of childhood deaths in Africa. Each contribution of \$10 will purchase one long-lasting, insecticide-treated bed net, designed to help prevent the transmission of malaria by mosquito bites. Mosquitos do their worst work at night and children are thus most vulnerable while they sleep.

There are ten new cases of malaria every second; every two minutes, a child in Africa dies of the disease. Malaria is destructive of more that just the lives list. Its spread consumes up to 40 percent of public health expenditures in some countries, 30 to 50 percent of hospital admissions and up to 60 percent of outpatient clinic costs. Malaria illness and death cost Africa about \$12 billion per year in lost productivity, school absenteeism, and diminished agricultural efficiency.
