Salary: Commensurate with experience and qualifications
Status: Part-time (approx. 3-5 hours/week)

Position Description:

The Music Director will have oversight of the chancel choir and will be responsible for the musical accompaniment on the organ/piano during the worship services on Sunday mornings and on other special occasions (weddings and funerals to be arranged separately). The Music Director will also have oversight of the handbell choir.

The Music Director will answer to the Staff-Parish Relations Committee and the pastor. The Music Director will work closely with the senior pastor in the selection of the musical offerings for each week for the worship service. The Music Director will also be responsible for working with the church's Worship Committee as deemed necessary.

The Music Director will also be responsible for communicating with the church office assistant and pastor in a timely and accurate manner with the information to be included in the weekly bulletin. The Music Director will also have budget oversight for the funds of the choir and music purchases. It is also the expectation that the Music Director will work with other musicians, both within the congregation and outside the congregation, for special music on occasion.

Qualifications:

The applicant should have skills and experience in leading choirs and in playing the organ and piano. No formal degree is required, though preference will be given to applicants with such credentials.
